Mr. Scott Roger is the Project Coordinator at the Pacific Financial Technical Assistance Centre (PFTAC) in Suva, Fiji. Previously Mr. Roger worked as a Senior Economist in the European Offices of the International Monetary Fund (IMF) in Paris (2010-2012); the Monetary and Capital Markets Department (2003-2010); and the Asia and Pacific Department (1998-2003). Prior to joining the IMF, Mr. Roger worked at the Reserve Bank of New Zealand (1993-1998), Bank for International Settlements (1991-1993) and Bank of Canada (1980-1991). Mr. Roger's research interests have included international reserves management, core inflation measurement, inflation targeting frameworks, policy formulation and policy communications, adaptation of inflation targeting to emerging and developing economies, currency baskets and, more recently, macrofinancial issues.
